	Action	Complete
1	The prospective pastor will meet with the Executive Director of the Gwinnett Baptist	-
	Network to:	
	a. Discuss desire to affiliate and come into membership.	
	b. Discuss qualifications for affiliating with the Network.	
	c. Discuss the process and expectations.	
	d. Receive an application and other appropriate documents.	
	Transferring from another Association? At this point the Executive Director of the	
	GMBN will contact the Director of your Association to discuss the request and desire for transfer. You will be contacted regarding next step #2 following that communication.	
2	An application should be submitted to the Executive Director which formally initiates the	
_	process.	
3	At the discretion of the Executive Director, the prospective pastor may be asked to meet	
	with teams or leaders from the Gwinnett Network to further vet and verify a consensus	
	relationship to move forward in the process.	
4	The church will be submitted to the Administrative Team or Executive Team for	
	approval to be brought into a Watch Care relationship.	
5	The Gwinnett Network will request SBC and GBMB ID numbers for the church if not	
	already established. (<i>This gives the church 501C3 status if needed</i>).	
	Are you a "church plant?" You will need to be "incorporated" as a church before	
•	becoming a full member. Begin that process now.	
<u>6</u>	The pastor will engage in a minimum of twelve (12) hours of selected Network activities	
	under the direction of the Executive Director including participation in Quarterly Watch Care Meetings (held in afternoon and evening hours with advance notice). <i>Non-</i>	
	participation and/or lack of progress can result in removal from Watch Care status.	
	Are you a "church plant?" You will need to grow your average worship attendance to	
	fifteen (15) or more to move to step #7. We want to help!	
7	The church will be submitted by the Executive Director to the Administrative Leadership	
_	Team (or Full Board) as a candidate for Membership within twelve months of the	
	receipt of application, having completed twelve (12) hours of engagement, meeting all	
	qualifications, and having established giving to the Network. Churches that do not	
	acquire Membership status and are not progressing within twelve months may be asked	
	to re-apply.	
	Are you a "church plant?" Please be aware that additional expectations are required	
	in order to be eligible for church planter funding.
